

Bond Project Descriptions

Technology	
District Wide Area Network	Fiber optic network to connect all schools in the district to handle future demands, save monthly costs, and improve internet performance – reducing testing time. Federal grants covering 75% of actual cost.
Student Computers	Needed to decrease amount of student time spent on state testing and to improve instructional delivery.
Classroom Projectors	Classroom projectors have become essential for instruction. Many across the District are no longer functioning properly due to age and wear.
New School Facilities to Prevent Overcrowding	
Phase 1 of New High School	Phase 1 of a 2,000 student comprehensive high school. Enrollment at existing high schools exceeds capacity and is increasing by over 150 students per year.
New K-8 School	Existing capacity at K-8 schools will be exceeded in the 19/20 school year. Enrollment is increasing by over 250 students per year.
Andrada Expansion	Facilities to add an additional pathway. Soccer field and tennis courts for student and community use.
Facilities for Required Preschool Special Ed (VIP)	Growing enrollment at VIP at Cienega is already requiring use of offsite temporary space. A new facility at a new location is needed.
Health and Safety	
OVMS Library	Replace 35 year old modular library. Facility is literally coming apart.
Repair Portable Classrooms at OVMS	Repair existing modular classrooms to address health and safety concerns.
Repair Restrooms	Restroom repairs at many schools across the District.
Carpet/Flooring	Replace torn/damaged carpet throughout the District.
Repair Middle and High School Fields	The rocky subsurface and a very high rate of student and community use have made playing fields dangerously barren and hard.
Mechanic Shop Expansion	Additional service bays are needed to ensure all buses in the expanding fleet are functional, safe, and available to be in service.
Maintenance Equipment	New schools are being added. As existing schools get older, proper maintenance is required to ensure they are safe and healthy places for students.
Transportation	
New Air Conditioned School Buses	New regular, special education, and activity buses. 19 buses have over 250,000 miles, and five buses currently have over 350,000 miles. Over the next five years a projection of over 2,000 students will be added to the District, and additional buses will be needed.
